* Students interested in the *Career or College Diploma* should determine by the end of sophomore year which direction they would like to go. Please make sure you are aware of the admissions requirements for potential colleges. Beginning with the class of 2026, UNC System schools will require a 2.5 GPA for admission. In addition, if the GPA is a 2.5—2.8, a SAT score of 930 or ACT Composite of 17 will be required in addition the following minimum courses -

- 4 English Courses
- 4 Math Courses (including one above Algebra II) *at least one in the 12th grade is highly recommended
- 3 Science Courses (including a life science, a physical science, and one additional lab course)
- 2 Social Studies Courses (including US History)
- 2 Additional Academic Courses - *2 Foreign Language Courses (of the same language) are highly recommended– if not foreign language, then two additional academic courses from the following are required: computer science, English, math, history, or science.
