
Burlington Christian Academy Middle School Program Overview "The H.U.B" Help..Unite..Build

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Academic Core Courses:

Our core curriculum challenges students across essential disciplines, providing a strong foundation for their future studies. Courses include:

- **Bible**: Deepening knowledge and understanding of scripture and Christian principles.
- **English & Literature**: Building critical reading, writing, and communication skills.
- Mathematics: Offering a progression from 6th Grade Math to Geometry, with Pre-Algebra and Algebra I in between to ensure a solid math foundation.
- **History**: Exploring World History and U.S. History to develop global awareness and an understanding of American heritage.
- Science: Encouraging inquiry and exploration of the natural world.

Diverse Specials:

Middle School students benefit from a wide range of special courses that foster creativity, practical skills, and personal interests. Each special meets for two periods daily, and offerings may vary by semester:

- Technology & Engineering: Computer, STEM, Engineering
- Arts & Media: Art, Media, Journalism, Creative Writing, Choir, Band
- Health & Wellness: Physical Education, Health and Wellness, Study Skills
- Languages: Introduction to Spanish, Spanish I

Extracurricular Activities:

BCA Middle School students have abundant opportunities to engage in sports and clubs, supporting both physical and social development:

- Athletics: Competitive sports include Soccer, Tennis, Basketball, Track and Field, Cheerleading, Cross Country, Baseball, Softball, Swimming, Golf, and Volleyball.
- Faith-Based and Service Clubs: Weekly Bible Study Groups, National Junior Honor Society, and mission-oriented service events connect students with the community and foster strong values.
- **Chapel and Spiritual Retreats**: Students participate in weekly chapel sessions with guest speakers and attend an annual threeday spiritual retreat, providing moments for reflection and faithbuilding.

Campus Ministry and Student Support:

Our two full-time Campus Ministry Directors—one male, one female provide mentorship and guidance, fostering meaningful relationships and discipleship among students. This support system strengthens student connections, encourages spiritual growth, and builds character.

BCA's Middle School program nurtures students to grow academically, spiritually, and personally—creating well-rounded individuals ready for high school and lifelong success.

Standardized Testing at Burlington Christian Academy

Each spring, BCA students participate in a nationally recognized standardized test to assess their annual academic progress. Our middle school students consistently score above both the North Carolina and national averages. Historically, BCA students perform within the top 15th percentile nationwide, reflecting our commitment to academic excellence.
