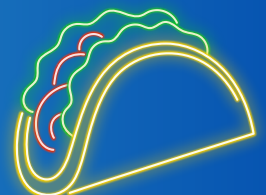

Our little Royals are growing and learning the truth. We are laying a good foundation in the course of their youth.

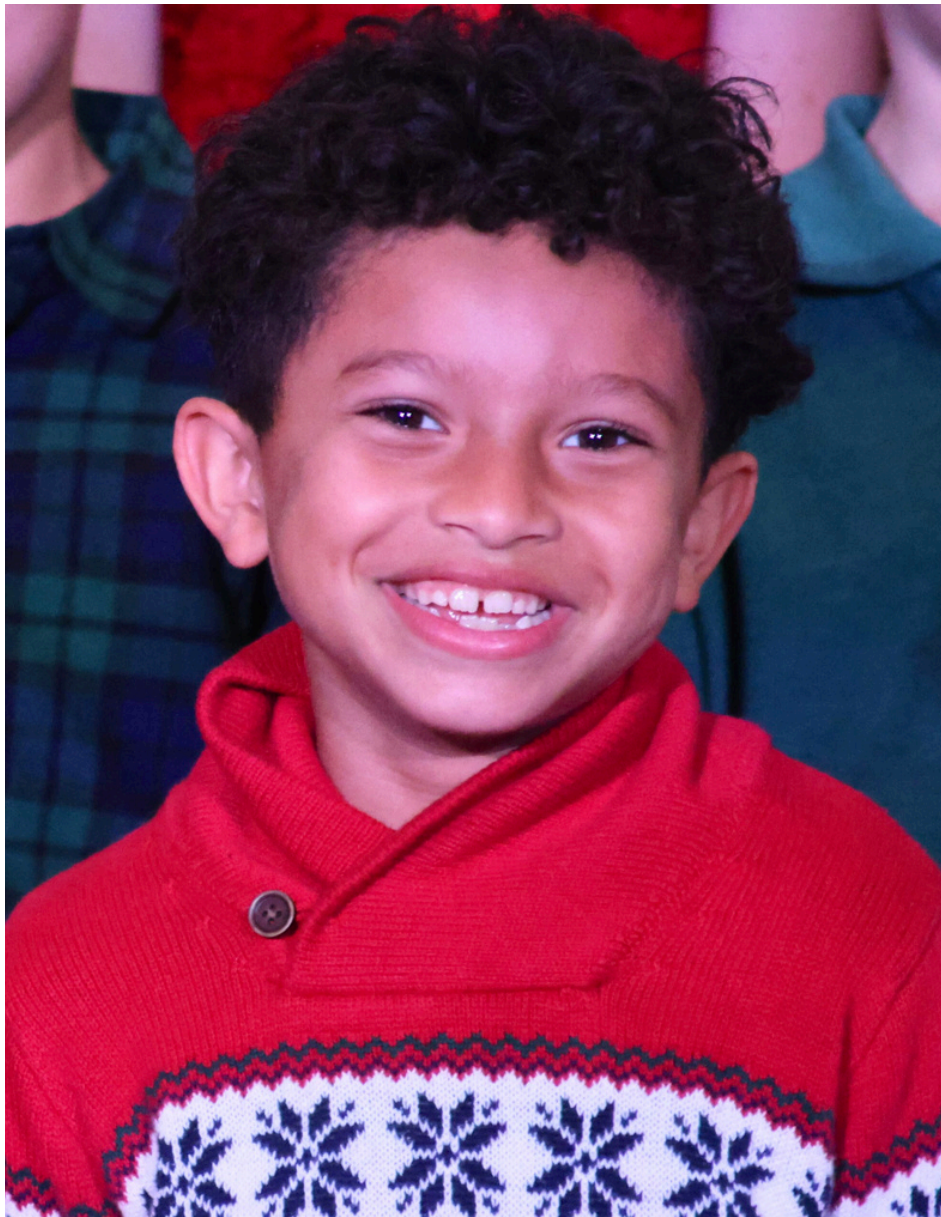

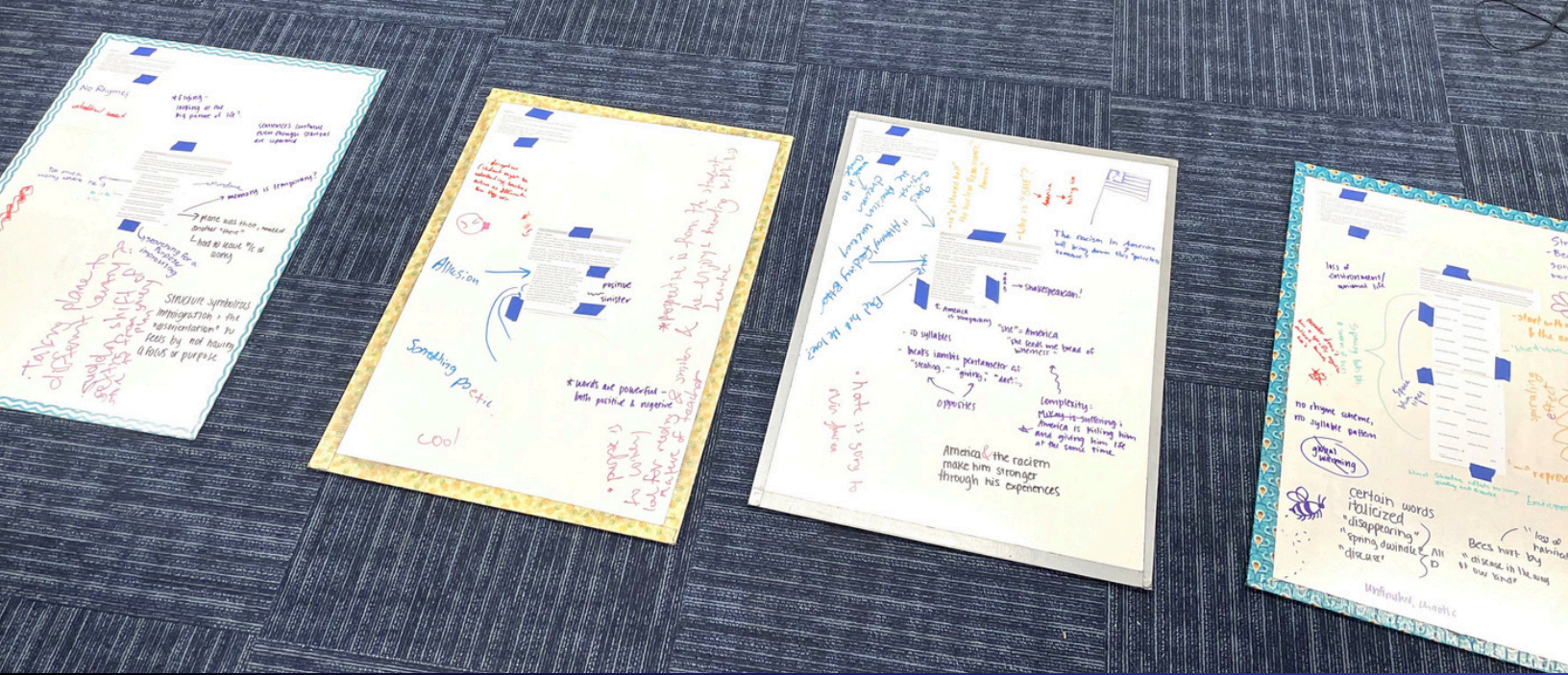
K5-8TH GRADE CHRISTMAS PROGRAMS 2024



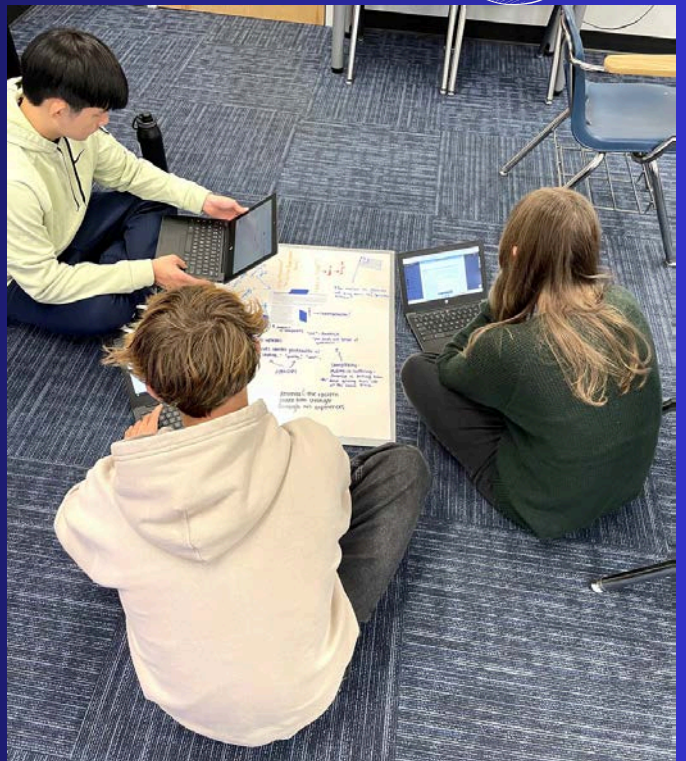
